

REPRESENTATION

Black representation on the boards of mining houses has increased from 0,08 percent in 2001 to 37 percent, says a report released by the executive research company Landelahni Business.

“This represents a significant shift since the mining charter was formulated in October 2002,” said Sandra Burmeister, Landelahni Group chief executive.

“At other levels representation in the mining industry trails the average across all industries.”
